Alternative Name : Cytosolic beta-glucosidase, Cytosolic beta-glucosidase-like protein 1, GBA3, CBG, CBGL1, Glucosidase Beta Acid 3, GH1, Glycoside Hydrolase Family 1, GLUC, KLRP.

Description

Source : E.coli. GBA3 produced in E.Coli is a single, non-glycosylated polypeptide chain containing 492 amino acids (1-469 a.a.) and having a molecular mass of 56.1kDa. GBA3 is fused to a 23 amino acid His-tag at N-terminus & purified by proprietary chromatographic techniques. Glucosidase Beta Acid 3, also known as GBA3, hydrolyzes various types of glycosides. GBA3 takes part in a nonlysosomal catabolic pathway of glycosylceramide. GBA3 is a protein coding gene which acts as beta-glycosylceramidase.

Product Info

Amount : 20 µg

Purification : Greater than 85% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Content : GBA3 protein solution (0.25mg/ml) containing Phosphate Buffered Saline (pH7.4), 20% glycerol and 1mM DTT.

Storage condition : Store at 4°C if entire vial will be used within 2-4 weeks. Store, frozen at -20°C for longer periods of time. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA). Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
