## **Description**

Source: E.coli. CD84 Human Recombinant produced in E. coli is a single polypeptide chain containing 302 amino acids (22-225) and having a molecular mass of 25.4 kDa.CD84 is fused to a 25 amino acid His-tag at N-terminus & purified by proprietary chromatographic techniques. CD84 belongs to the signaling lymphocyte activation molecule (SLAM) family which forms a subset of the greater CD2 cell-surface receptor Ig superfamily. CD84, a membrane glycoprotein, is a homophilic adhesion molecule found in various immune cells types and takes part in regulating receptor-mediated signaling in those cells.
