

32-5718: Recombinant Dengue Virus NS1 Subtype 3, Insect Cells

Description

Source : Insect cells. Recombinant Dengue Virus NS1 Subtype 3 produced in Insect Cells is a polypeptide chain containing amino acids 775-1129 and having a molecular weight of approximately 50kDa. Dengue NS1 ST3 is purified by proprietary chromatographic technique. Caused by one of four closely related virus serotypes of the genus *Flavivirus*, family *Flaviviridae*, each serotype is sufficiently different that there is no cross-protection and epidemics caused by multiple serotypes (hyperendemicity) can occur. In cell culture experiments and mice Morpholino antisense oligos have shown specific activity against Dengue virus.

Amount :	10 µg
Purification :	Protein is >95% pure as determined by 12.5% SDS-PAGE.
Content :	Dengue NS1 ST3 protein solution (1mg/ml) in 1xPBS, pH7.4, 0.1% Thimerosal, 5mM EDTA, 1µg/ml of Leupeptin, Aprotinin and Pepstatin A.
Storage condition :	Store at 4°C if entire vial will be used within 2-4 weeks. Store, frozen at -20°C for longer periods of time. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA). Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
