Recombinant Human Protocadherin-10 is produced by our Mammalian expression system and the target gene encoding Gln19-Thr715 is expressed with a Fc tag at the C-terminus. Protocadherin-10 (PCDH10) is a single-pass type I membrane protein that contains six extracellular cadherin domains, one transmembrane domain and one cytoplasmic tail differing from those of the classical cadherins. As a potential calcium-dependent cell-adhesion neuronal receptor, it may plays a role in the establishment and function of specific cell-cell connections in the brain. PCDH10 moderately expressed in all regions of the brain examined, as well as in testis and ovary, and low expression in all other tested tissues.

Application Note

Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than 100 \tilde{A} $\hat{A}\mu g/ml$. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in ddH2O. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Endotoxin : Less than 0.1 ng/ \tilde{A}] \hat{A} µg (1 IEU/ \tilde{A}] \hat{A} µg) as determined by LAL test.
