GDF-15 regulates inflammatory and apoptotic pathways during cellular stress and injury. GDF-15 is emerging as a biomarker of early heart disease, such that increased levels of circulating GDF-15 are associated with an increased risk of developing heart failure.

Endotoxin: Less than 0.1 ng/ $\tilde{A} \square \hat{A} \mu g$ (1 IEU/ $\tilde{A} \square \hat{A} \mu g$) as determined by LAL test.

Centrifuge vial before opening, Suspend the product by gently pipetting the above recommended solution down the sides of the vial. DO NOT VORTEX. Allow several minutes for complete reconstitution.
