BSA makes up about half of the protein in plasma and represents the most stable and soluble protein in the plasma. It is a suitable reagent for laboratories developing immunoassays, mostly due to its availability, solubility and the numerous functional groups present for coupling. The BSA component contains several lysines that are capable of reacting with conj $\hat{A}\mu$ gation sites of linkers, making it applicable as a carrier protein for antigenic compounds.
