

## 32-17317: Recombinant human IFNGR2 protein with C-terminal human Fc tag

**Alternative Name :** AF-1; IFGR2; IFNGT1; IMD28

### Description

Expression Host : HEK293

The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 60.1 kDa after removal of the signal peptide.

This gene (IFNGR2) encodes the non-ligand-binding beta chain of the gamma interferon receptor. Human interferon-gamma receptor is a heterodimer of IFNGR1 and IFNGR2. Defects in IFNGR2 are a cause of mendelian susceptibility to mycobacterial disease (MSMD), also known as familial disseminated atypical mycobacterial infection. MSMD is a genetically heterogeneous disease with autosomal recessive, autosomal dominant or X-linked inheritance.

<b>Amount :</b>	50 µg
<b>Purification :</b>	The purity of the protein is greater than 95% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining.
<b>Content :</b>	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose is added as protectants before lyophilization.
<b>Storage condition :</b>	Store at -80°C for 12 months (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing)
