32-17934: Recombinant Human CD19 Protein, mFc Tag

Description

Molecular Characterization: CD19(Pro20-Lys291) mFc(Pro99-Lys330)

Molecular weight: The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 56.3 kDa after removal of the signal peptide. The apparent molecular mass of CD19-mFc is approximately 70-100 kDa due to glycosylation.

Description: Recombinant human CD19 protein with C-terminal mouse Fc tag

Lymphocytes proliferate and differentiate in response to various concentrations of different antigens. The ability of the B cell to respond in a specific, yet sensitive manner to the various antigens is achieved with the use of low-affinity antigen receptors. This gene encodes a cell surface molecule which assembles with the antigen receptor of B lymphocytes in order to decrease the threshold for antigen receptor-dependent stimulation.

Amount : $100 \mu g / 50 \mu g$

Content: Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8% trehalose is added as protectants before

lyophilization.

Store at -20 $^{\circ}$ C to -80 $^{\circ}$ C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended

Storage condition : for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing).

Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient temperature.
